1. Write Paul's prayer in your own words. Describe your prayer life, specifically intercessory prayer for others? What do you pray about when you pray for others? Does this prayer change the way you will pray for others? How?
2. Does this prayer summarize the desire of your heart for your own life? How is this demonstrated (or not) in your life?
3. What does it look like for someone to abound more and more in love for God and for people?
4. How has your knowledge and depth of insight for Jesus changed (grown or diminished) over this past year? What area of knowledge of God would you really like to grow in for 2012? What is your plan for this?
5. What is the fruit of righteousness and does this describe your life? What needs to change?
6. What can we learn from Paul's attitude in verses 12-14?
