

LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. In this parable, what was the king inviting his guests to? In normal circumstances, what would be people's response to an invitation like this? Who are the invited guests?

2. Why did they refuse to come?

3. Who actually came to the wedding banquet? Why were they invited? What does this say about the heart of God?

4. In normal circumstances, the people on the street corners and in the hi-ways and by-ways would not be invited to a royal wedding. What would their response have been, especially considering they were given wedding clothes to wear? Would they enjoy the banquet? Does this have an impact on our understanding, appreciation, and enjoyment of being invited to this banquet?

5. What are the wedding clothes? How are they put on? Do a study on the spiritual clothes/robes that we are to put on. Be ready to share the verses you find and what you learn. (Galatians 3:26-27 is a good place to start)

6. Read Luke 14:15-24. How are these two parables different?
