3. Would you consider yourself a light? What does a light (as Paul is talking about in this passage) look like? How can you grow in this area?

4. What does it mean to hold out the word of life? What does it look like? Do you find it challenging to talk about Jesus with the non-believers around you?

5. How is it possible to have joy in a jail cell? How is it possible to rejoice in someone else's suffering, such as Paul is talking about in vs 17&18?
